For this reason, that when we do open, it will be under the stipulation that all those who come to the golf course are strictly abiding by the rules that we have set in place to protect everyone.

At this time, we are planning on opening the golf course by early May with guidelines in place to combat the spread of COVID-19 in our facility and community. Of course, this depends on the government relaxing their compulsory shutdown of certain businesses. These are extraordinary times and they call for extraordinary measures. When we do open with new mandatory guidelines we could be shut down again because of just one person not abiding by our regulations. So, we are asking everyone to please honor the guidelines we have set below or we will be forced to ask them to leave our property.

Guidelines and Expectations from golfers:

- If you have a cough, fever or have been in contact with someone who is not feeling well, stay home. If you have traveled outside of the country or province in the last 14 days or have been in contact with someone who has, stay home. Anyone not abiding by these regulations will be asked to leave and not return for 14 days.
- Tee times and inquiries over the phone.
- We strongly encourage membership/green fee payments by e-transfer, cheque, or credit card, via email or phone. Tap payments available on site when the clubhouse opens.
- Practice Social Distancing, remain 6 feet apart from others at ALL TIMES (parking lot, tee boxes, putting greens, fairways, everywhere) No playing through or "pushing" those ahead.
- A hand sanitizer, if available, will be set up at the course and upon entry, use will be mandatory.
- Golfers are encouraged to bring towels, hand sanitizer and other such items to help keep their high contact areas on their cart, golf balls and clubs clean. Do not pick up found tees or balls.
- Flagsticks are to remain in the hole. We have raised the cup out of the hole so all shots that contact the cup are deemed holed. Groups may also implement the COVID-19 Rule – All putts within 4ft are a gimmie!

- Walking is encouraged but if you are riding in a golf cart, ensure that your cellphone and personal property remain in your golf bag unless using your private cart. Please keep them away from high contact areas of the cart.
- Rental carts will be sanitized between users. No rental clubs. All carts only 1 person unless from the same household.
- High touch items such as ball washers and rakes will be removed.
- Washrooms will be available individually, using distancing requirements of 3 people in the club house at one time.
- Signage with information on social distancing, expectations of golfers, and policy changes will be posted.
- Staff will be properly equipped and trained on the proper cleaning and sanitation practices we have in place.
- Employees on site will be kept to a minimum, so please be patient and understanding.

Our Restaurant

- Dining room will be closed, only walk through traffic to our washrooms and to pick up orders will be permitted
- Kitchen will open on a take out, limited menu basis only until it is safe to fully open the dine-in options.
- Golfers may order items from our limited menu to take on the golf course.
- Only 3 individuals allowed in the clubhouse at one time. Lines will be set on the ground to show proper social distancing when waiting for your order.
- Beverage cart operation is yet to be determined
